

# PREPARATION INSTRUCTIONS AND NOTICE OF SCHEDULED PEST CONTROL SERVICES

**We will be treating your home for German Cockroaches and the following preparations must be made before your technician arrives.**

- Remove all items from your lower kitchen cabinets, place in the living room and cover with a sheet. Also remove and empty the drawers. Remove food from the pantry. If roaches have been seen in the upper cabinets, remove contents as well.
- Pull the stove and refrigerator away from the wall and clean if necessary.
- Move furniture away from walls by 2 feet if seeing roaches in those areas
- Eliminate trash, bags, boxes and other debris that might harbor roaches.
- If roaches are seen in the bedroom: remove items from the closet shelves and remove your top dresser drawers.
- Cats, and dogs must be removed from your home. Aquariums need to be covered with a towel or sheet and aerators turned off. Other small pets can be caged in the bedroom and covered with a sheet.
- Remove items from under the bathroom sink.

**Be prepared to leave for up to 4 hours when your technician arrives.**

## POST APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

**Upon returning:** Wash your kitchen counter tops and other food handling surfaces with soapy water. If plates, dishes, pots and pans were left on the counters, wash them in soapy water. Sweep up any dead roaches and flush them down the toilet. You may put your items back in the cupboards if they are dry.

You may see roaches for a while after our treatment and a follow up service will be needed to eliminate them. Your landlord or management company will contact you for this service. It is usually best to treat again in 3 to 4 weeks until all roaches are gone.

Customer co operation and properly preparing your unit is essential for your technician to provide a thorough treatment. Eliminating clutter and good sanitation will speed up getting control and give you longer-term results.
